English: Fiction

Narrative – focus on building suspense.

Model text: Wolf Brother by Michelle Paver

SPAG:

English: Non Fiction

Persuasive writing – adverts.

Model text: Various examples of persuasive adverts

Main focus:

- using rhetorical questions
- hyperbole (exaggeration)
- creating catchy slogans



Maths

Multiplication and division: Continuing to learn multiplication and division facts for tables up to 12 x 12. Multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100. Recognising multiples and factors.

Year 5 – identifying prime, square and cube numbers.

Perimeter: You will find the perimeter of different shapes and solve a range of problems.

Area (Year 5 only): Year 5 children will learn about finding the area of different shapes.

People of God: How does following God bring freedom and justice?

You will learn about the key events in the life of Moses, including the ten plagues of Egypt and the Ten Commandments.



Science

Light

You will learn about how light travels and how we see things.

You will explore how mirrors are used to reflect light.

You will investigate shadows.

You will explore how light is made up of different colours.



History

Stone Age to Iron Age (contd)

You will learn about how life for humans in Britain changed from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.

You will use a range of sources and begin to consider the reliability of these sources.

You will learn about the work of archaeologists relating to prehistoric artefacts.

Word processing

You will continue to develop word processing skills, including inserting images into a document in order to create a persuasive advert.



Design Technology

Moving Toys

You will explore moving toys.

You will design and make a moving toy.
