Recounts

You will read different examples of recounts of real and fictional events and use the features to write a recount of your own.



Maths

Time

You will develop your understanding of telling the time to the nearest minute, converting analogue and digital time with the 12 and 24 hour clocks, and solve problems involving hours, minutes and seconds; and days, weeks, months and years.

Properties of shapes

You will increase your understanding of 2D and 3D shapes, as well as comparing and ordering different angles.
