English: Fiction

You will write a meeting tale inspired by the Legend of Podkin One-Ear and other furry heroes from our favourite books.

You will develop your skill and understanding of writing settings that interest and excite the reader.

English: Non Fiction

You will write a discussion text where you will learn how to present different sides of an argument or discussion.

Maths

Place value: You will develop your knowledge and understanding of working 3 digit numbers and how they can be represented in different ways. You will use this knowledge and understanding to solve a variety of problems.

Four operations: You will continue to develop your confidence in using mental and written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

The creation story

You will learn about the Creation story in Genesis 1 and 2

You will learn that there are different interpretations of the Creation story and reflect on what the story means to Christians.

Science

Rocks

You will learn how to compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their simple physical properties, the different types of rocks and how they are formed.

You will also learn about fossils and how they are formed.

History

You will learn about how life for humans in Britain changed from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.

You will use a range of sources and begin to consider the reliability of these sources. You will learn about the work of archaeologists relating to prehistoric artefacts.

You will learn about the artists Henry Moore.

You will develop your drawing skills when creating form and shading. You will also respond to the sculpture work of Henry Moore and create your own piece of sculpture at the end of the unit.
